★★★★ **Sauvignon Blanc:** Night-harvested **06** has super-fresh feel with whiffs greenpepper & green grass, rounded yet crisp, usual commendably, low 12.5% alc.

★★★☆☆ **Chenin Blanc:** **06** again satisfies with floral aromas, lightish rounded tropical flavours, fresh just-dry finish

★★★★ **Gewürztraminer Special Late Harvest**
Beguiling scented dessert. **06** billows jasmine, honeysuckle & rose, rounded & smooth rather than sweet; best in bloom of youth. 😊

★★★★☆ **Cabernet Sauvignon:** **05** exactly as pvs; smooth, soft, approachable, some quite stylish red berry fruit & whiffs spice, vanilla from 7 mths French oaking. ✓

★★★★☆ **Pinotage:** Delightful **05** with plum/banana scents, ripe berry flavours; trim, elegant & well behaved for this feisty grape. ✓

★★★★☆ **Shiraz:** **05** alive with herbs, black pepper & ripe berry fruit, toasty oak backup; rounded & supple enough to drink now or keep yr/2. ✓
