### VINEYARDS

After experimenting in the vineyard for a couple of years we are now confident that we know the viticultural recipe to create a light range of varietal wines with exceptional quality at a very modest alcohol level.

Some of the older Chenin Blanc vineyards were selected to be harvested for this wine. The older Chenin Blanc vineyards normally, over time, reach a natural balance between crop level and canopy size. Vineyards selected for this wine are some of the less vigorous growing Chenin Blancs with an open canopy that allows enough diffused sunlight into the canopy. This diffused sunlight enhances the development of the tropical flavours of this wine.

### WINEMAKER'S COMMENT

Bouquet: Tropical with apples.  
Taste: Upfront tropical fruit with floral notes.  
With food: Great with sushi or smoked salmon.
